PHP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM for HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

The PHP Scholarship Program is offered to high school seniors planning to pursue a degree in a health-related field. Our goal is to provide today's youth opportunities for continued success as tomorrow's healthcare professionals. Scholarship winners will be awarded scholarship monies payable to the student and the accredited post-secondary college, university or technical school.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a high school senior planning to pursue a degree in a health-related field with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- Be either a PHP/ProClaim member or attend high school in the PHP service area. (www.phpni.com/about/areas-we-serve).
- Have applied/accepted by an accredited post-secondary college, university, or technical school.
- Complete a Scholarship Application Form (See your Guidance Counselor or visit phpni.com).
- Submit a typewritten, double-spaced, 1,000-word essay on the chosen essay topic. All submitted work must be cited and documented.

2020-2021 ESSAY TOPIC

COVID-19 has been a major source of stress, confusion and fear for the world for several months. Public health actions, such as social distancing and the closing of businesses and schools, continues to affect the lives of every American in many ways. Please discuss and analyze how the COVID-19 pandemic has specifically impacted the mental and behavioral health of individuals and their families, and if the risks of lifting these closures outweigh the threat to our collective wellbeing. (Note: use statistics to support your conclusions.)



AWARDS: First place award: \$3,000 one-time scholarship; Second place: \$2,000 one-time scholarship; Third place: \$1,000 one-time scholarship

SCORING: PHP has sole responsibility for selecting the scholarship winners. The scholarship winners are chosen based on the following criteria: Qualities of application and the essay, including, but not limited to: content, grammar, punctuation, spelling, and creativity (70%).

Length of commitment, quality of teamwork and leadership responsibilities in the community, and school studies, activities, awards, and honors (30%).
